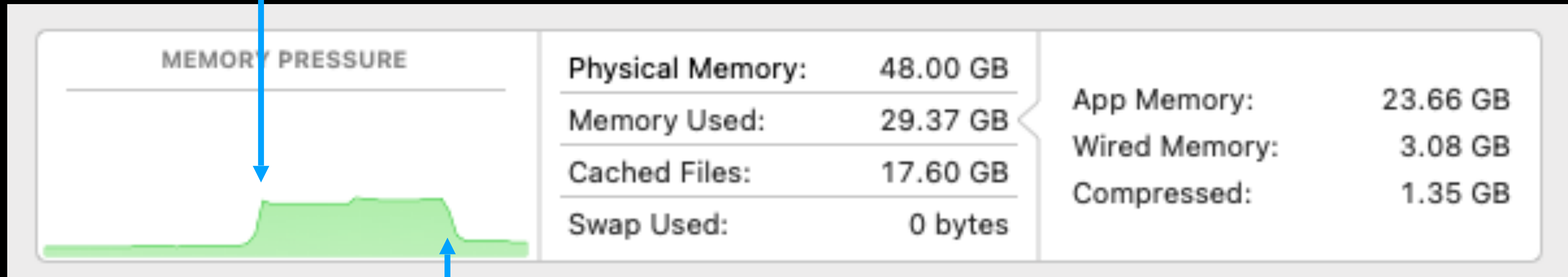
- Nvidia CUDA, AMD Ryzen, Mac M-Series processor, or a fast CPU

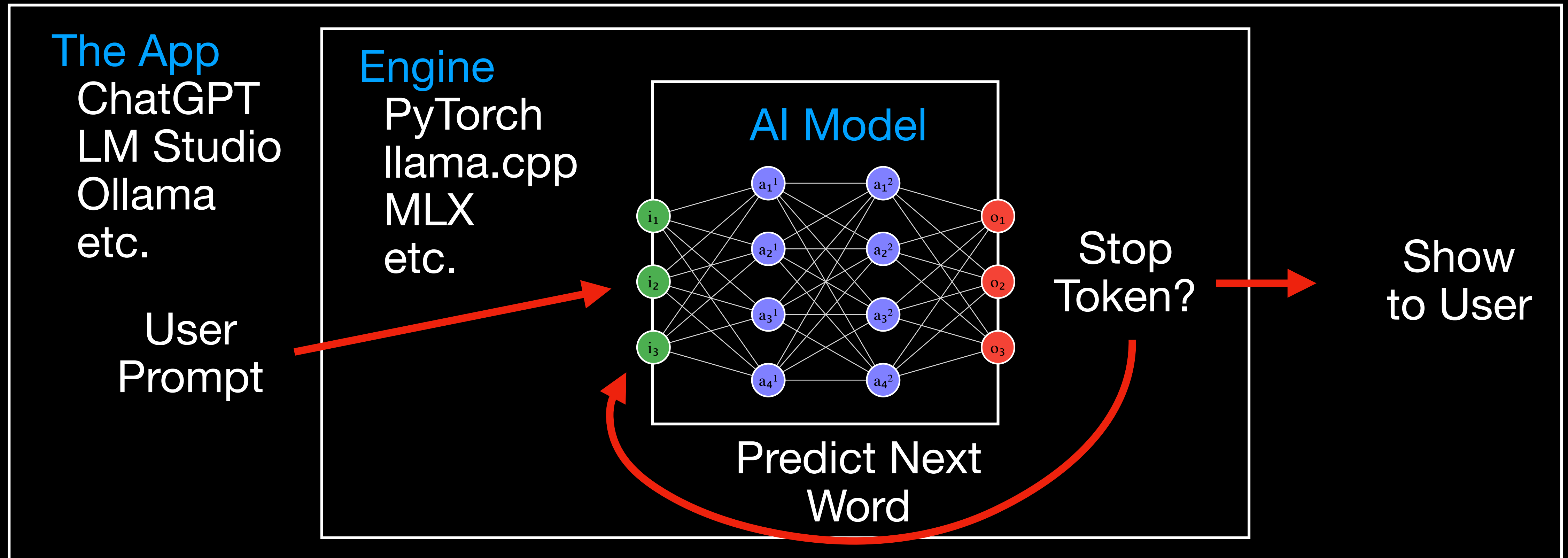

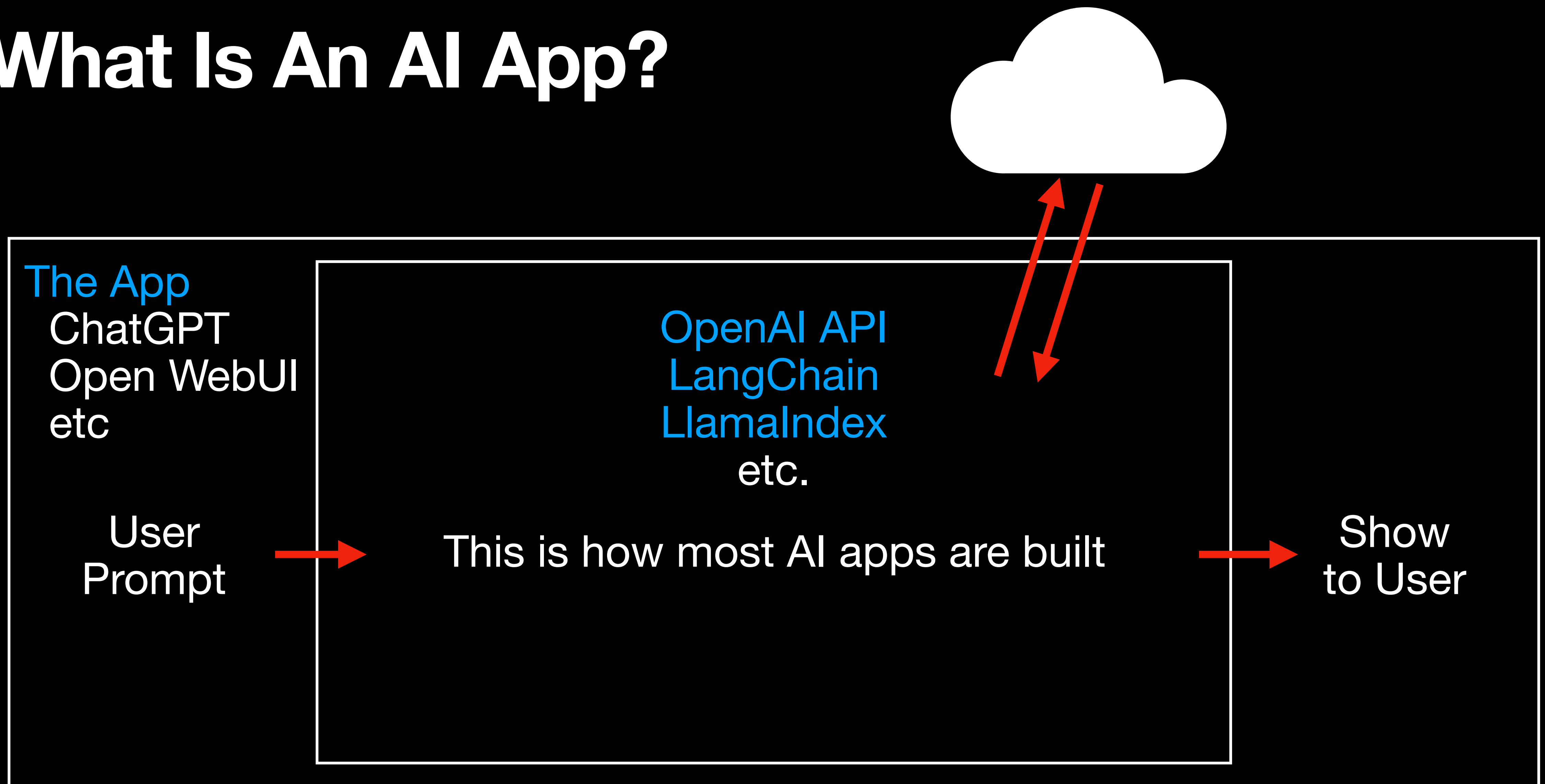
How to Improve AI?

- Function calling (including MCP)

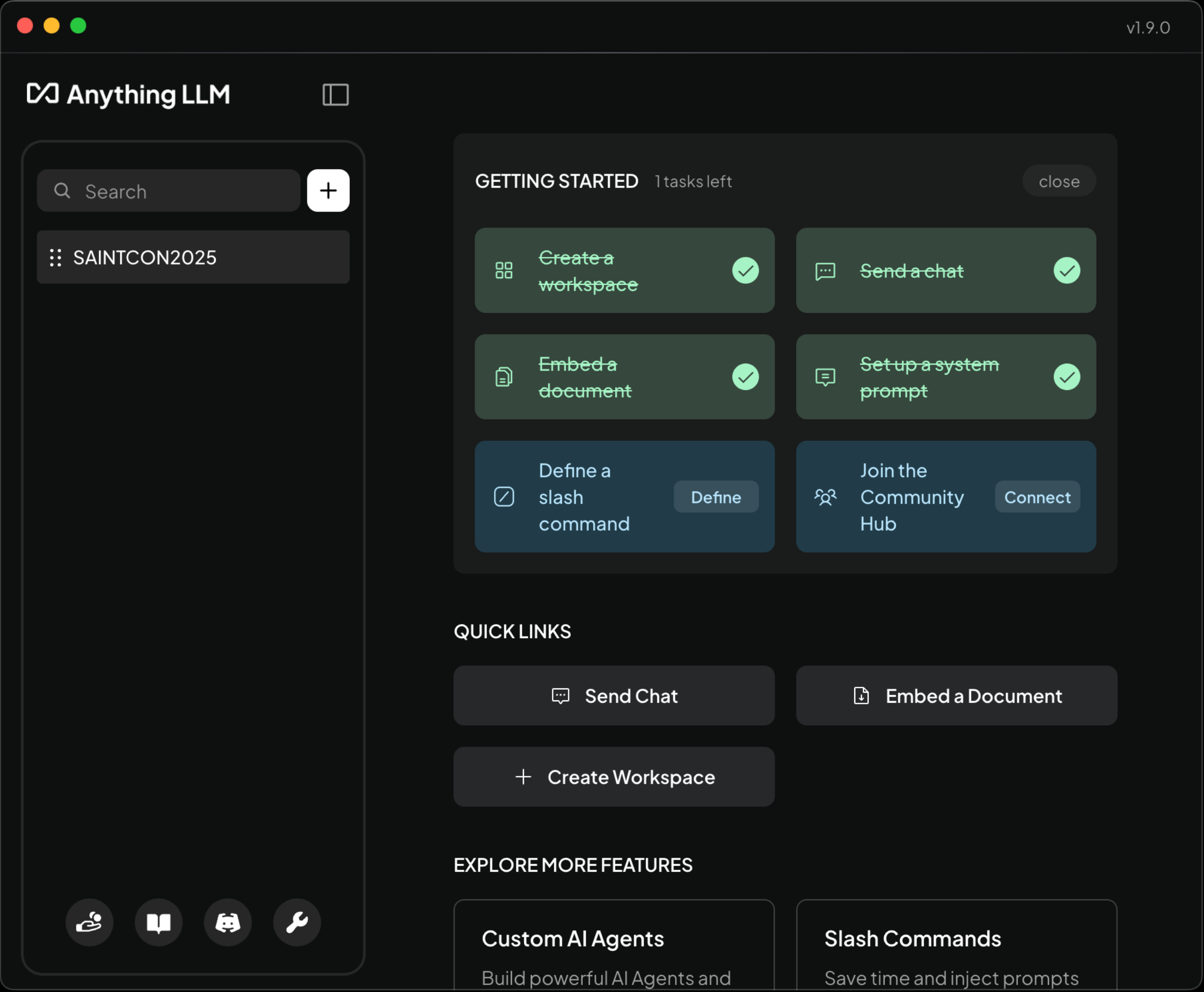
Context Limitations

- Soft maximum size
 - When it's above this limit it forgets stuff at the beginning or middle
- Hard maximum size
 - If it's too big it just gets cut off
- Mitigations
 - Rolling context window (forgets the beginning of the chat)
 - Summarize the past chat history (takes extra time to summarize)

03. Otherwise, expand its neighbors: update their g , h , and f values if a better path is found, and add them to the open list.

That's A* in a nutshell – a fast, informed search that finds optimal paths when the heuristic is good.

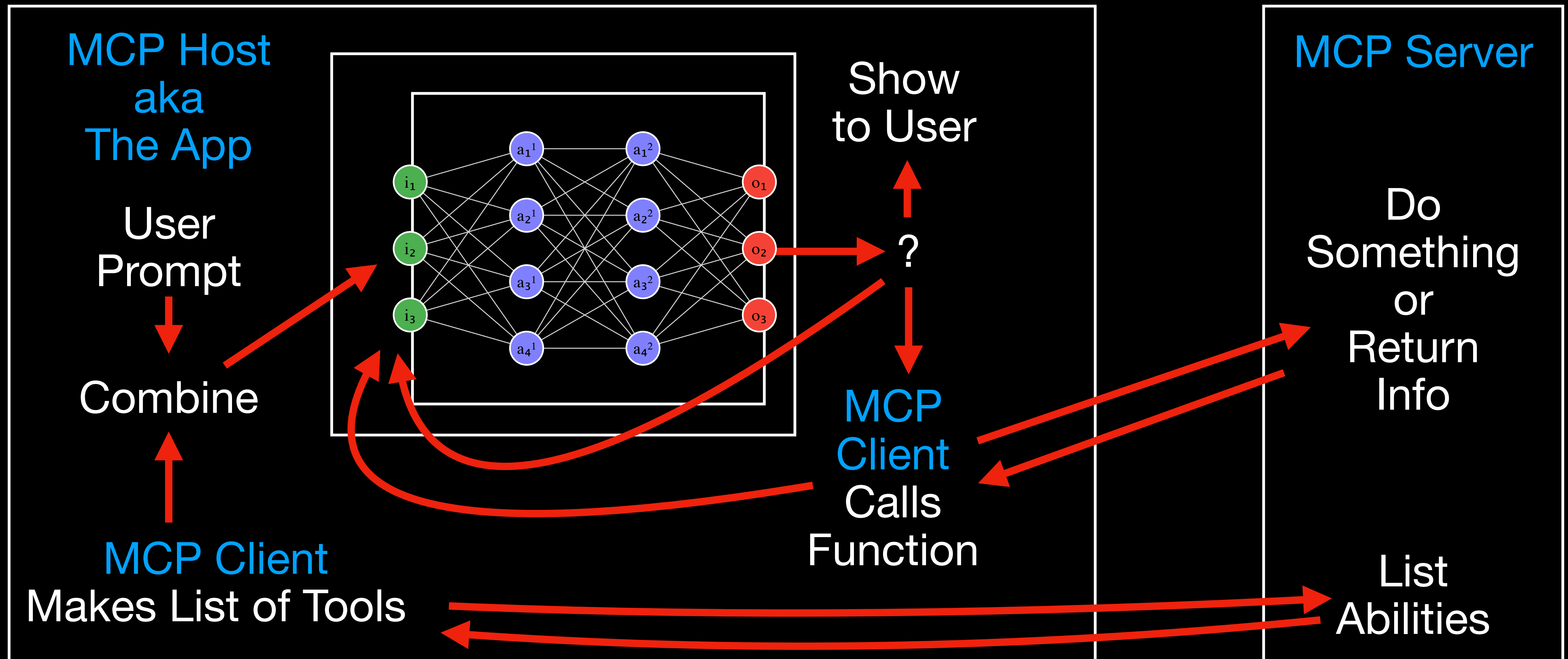


Each of the `<|...|>` tokens tell the LLM what to do or it's a stop token and gives the app a chance to intervene.

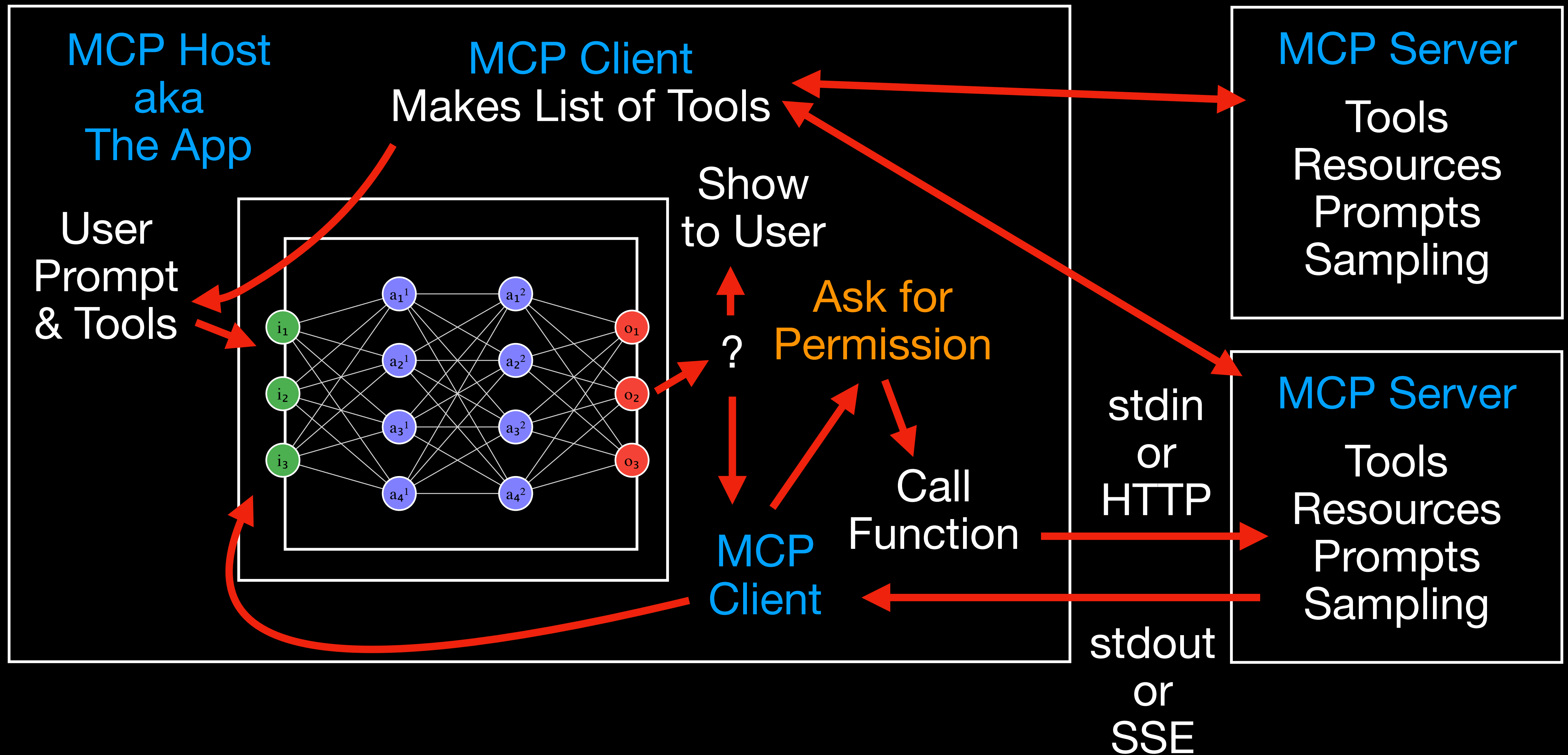
This works because of **model training**.

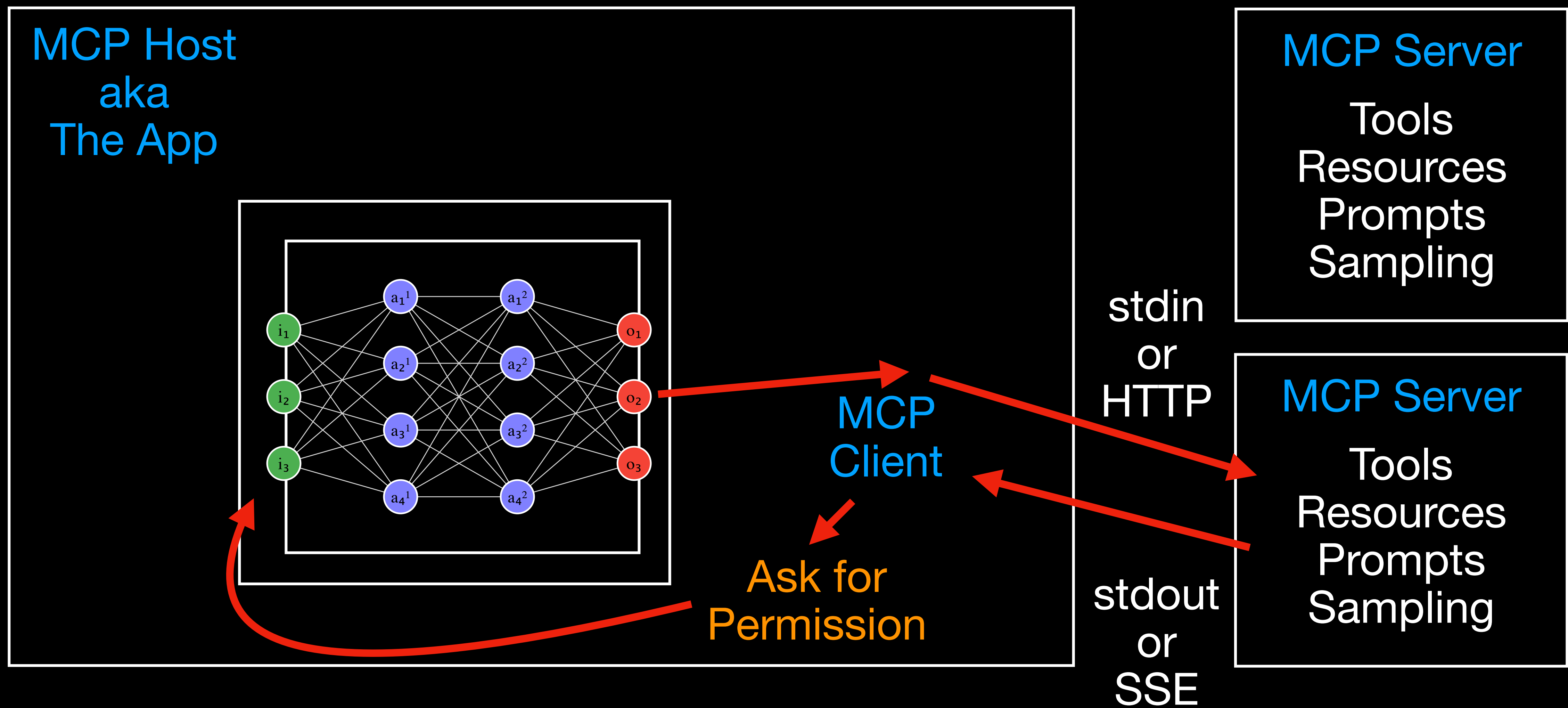
